REMINDERS

Unlawful to feed waterfowl

An overabundance of resident geese and ducks can lead to severe degradation of lake water quality. Please remember the following code applies: "It shall be unlawful for any person to feed any migratory waterfowl on any publicly or privately owned property in the Township of Medford" (Chapter 144-2, Medford Code)

Other Wildlife Etiquette

Please remember that your actions may affect others in a negative way. No one should feed deer or turkeys in a neighborhood setting because doing so encourages these wild animals to spend much of their time in the area where they are fed. This leads to property damage caused by grazing deer and defecation by turkeys on various household items and yards. You may like the wildlife but it may be causing damage to your neighbor's property.

All watercraft on the lake or stored on the beach racks must have a current boat sticker.

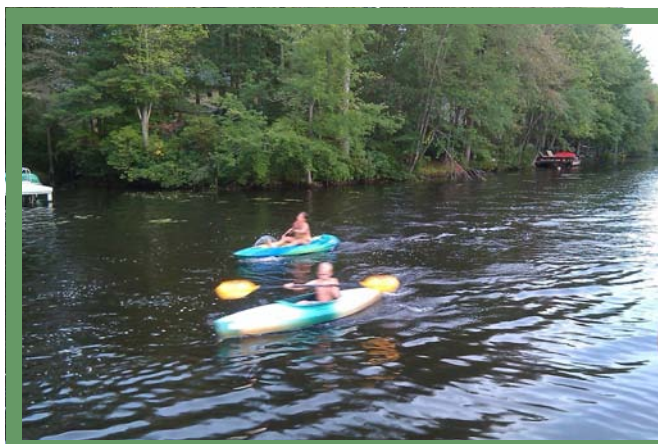

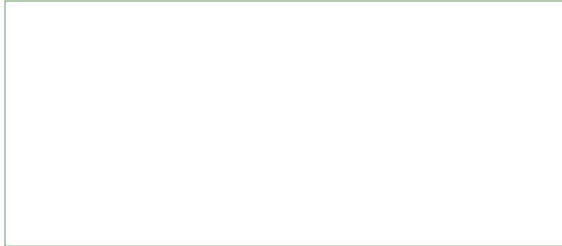
