Ice Skating Safety Tips:

Check the ice before skating. Safe skating ice is at least 4 inches thick.

NEVER skate alone. Always have at least two people present.

Children should NEVER be allowed to skate or walk on the ice unsupervised.

Beware of ice around partially submerged objects, such as docks, bulkheads, trees, and dam structures.

Do not congregate in one area.

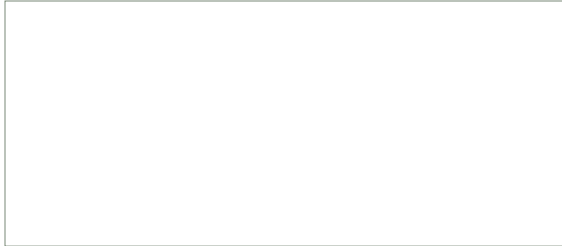
Stay away from cracks, seams, pressure ridges, slushy areas and darker areas that signify thinner ice.

Have rescue equipment available at all times (life rings, floatation devices, ladders, and ropes) .
