

# Oakwood Lakes Facility Use Rules

## General Access to Common Areas

- 1) Access shall be permitted to all common area to all Full Rate-Current (In Good Standing) Members of Oakwood Lakes Community Association.
- 2) Members will display current beach badges when on the common grounds or fishing in the lake, and boats on the lake or in the boat rack will display current Oakwood boat decals.
- 3) Guests are permitted, but must be accompanied by a member in good standing of the Association. No exceptions permitted. [E.g., "John Doe lives here and told me I can fish here anytime I want" is not permitted under any circumstances.] Similarly, boats with Oakwood decals are not to be used on the lake by non-members without a member in good standing.
- 4) When arriving at the beach, a member of the party with a current beach badge shall sign in with the lifeguard and indicate the number of persons in the party.

## Beach

- 1) Instructions by the lifeguard will be obeyed or the noncompliant members/guests will be asked to leave.
- 2) Parents are responsible for their children, who are not to be left unattended. The lifeguard is not a babysitter. Parents shall control children from littering the area with food items, wrappers, juice boxes and straw/wrappers and promptly clean up any items left by children. Parents shall also prevent children from climbing on canoe racks, watercraft, cooking area or any other destructive behavior.
- 3) Trash or debris is to be placed in the appropriate trash or recycle bins.
- 4) The volleyball, playground and other equipment is jointly owned by the members and for their enjoyment. Please respect it and use it properly.

## Picnic Area

- 1) The picnic area may be used by members in good standing for private parties, who are asked to register their dates with Colleen Wood, who manages the schedule. This is not to provide exclusive use of the picnic area to any group, but to communicate and avoid conflicts as a courtesy for member scheduling.
- 2) Users must clean up after their event and move full trash/recycling containers out to the street for township pick-up.

## Fishing & Boating

- 1) Boating and fishing is permitted by members in good standing with a current year Oakwood Decal affixed prominently on each side of watercraft. Anyone without a current decal will be asked to leave the lake area.
- 2) All fishing is on a "catch and release" basis only. No one shall take any fish from the lake for any purpose.
