Speed Bump – the Medford police conducted a speed study that we requested. The conclusion showed that an average of 800 cars passed through Oakwood Drive, but the average speed travelled did not exceed the limits required to justify installing a speed bump. However, the MPD has indicated they will be increasing patrols in the community and will be ticketing speeders.
