






How long have you lived in Oakwood Lakes?



Top 3 themes

Lake/Beach

- The lake
- A lack of a capital expenditure fund and plan for lake sustainability
- The depth of the lake as it mucks in with leaf and other debris. It needs dredging. We used to swim off out dock. There's now a foot of sludge in the bottom.
 The lake is never lowered enough for me to dig it out.
- Lakebed stumps; lack of dredging (create more islands &/or shoreline property with spoils)
- Underwater obstructions like fallen trees.
- We worry about the depth of the lake
- o Miss the rope tree swing for the kids! And wish there was a cost effective way to remove the silt and brush from the lake
- Wish the lake was cleaned up, dredged, and beach was nicer
- The beach starts to look gross as the summer goes on (debris, goose poop, weeds in sand)
- The depth of the lake and minimal communication... I know everyone is volunteering so I understand but I do really like how things seem to be changing in that regard.
- The lake is sometimes low and not great for swimming.

Trustees

- Membership should vote on the use of funds not have the board unilaterally decide. le Money shouldn't be spent on WiFi at the beach, unlimited data is
 pretty universal. (put in like the most section)
- There is too much work for the Board to do by itself, yet we have encountered resistance when offering to Chair Sub-Committees to look into issues (eg Lake, Wildlife). We understand and respect the efforts of all existing Board members, but we'd really like to be permitted to help in some meaningful way.
- The lack of HOA Board consideration for and meaningful involvement opportunities for the residents.
- Lack of communication, though improving lately.




Birchwood Lakes










- New to the neighborhood (8)

Which demographic does your household identify with?


